AUNER: Facts



- Ethical research and Independent Ethics
 Committee (IEC) are very weak and disparate in Africa;
- Important ethical challenge facing Africa with respect to the present medical situation (COVID) and human research;
- Lack of coordination between African countries in ethical guidelines.

AUNER: Facts



- Need for positive efforts to raise effective awareness on the Ethical research issues in Africa;
- Need to encourage the creation of a knowledgebased and innovative society and to promote the creation;
- Need of Harmonized Ethical research guidelines in the AU and Its Member States.

AUNER: Objectives



- Promote ethical research at our Member
 States level and at the level of the AU;
- Work together and safeguard Africa's Clinical Research;
- Protect the rights, safety, and wellbeing of all human research participants.

AUNER: Objectives



- Build a robust network of Experts, Societies and Agencies on Clinical Research;
- Provide strong and independent information on the Research Ethics;
- Develop, adopt, implement and evaluate Clinical Research policies in Africa;
- Safeguard our descendant future and resources.



- Develop, update, and Harmonize a guideline for good Clinical Research practices;
- Facilitate the use of Ethical standards to promote Ethical Clinical research and creativity;
- Facilitate/promote the realization and harmonization of national legislation and regional treaties and Ethical standards at all the AU levels.



- Assist African Union Member States upon request in formulating policies;
- Initiate and facilitate strategies that shall promote and develop a robust African Clinical Research, and Ethical practices;
- Strengthen the existing National IEC and facilitate their establishment in Member States, which have no such committees.



- Develop policy guidelines using best practices and training modules;
- Provide a forum for policy discussions and formulation, addressing political issues;
- Develop African Common position related to Clinical Research practices and Ethics.



- Take deliberate measures to promote the protection of Research output within the AU Member States;
- Collect, process and disseminate relevant information to Member States;
- Support the establishment of continental databases on Clinical Research and Challenges by establishing the African Clinical Research information portal.



- Produce the Africa Clinical Research outlook biennial;
- Promote and facilitate positive efforts to raise awareness on Research Ethics challenges in Africa;
- Initiate and facilitate activities that strengthen the human, financial and technical capacity of Member States and the African Communities at large.



- Advice the ASRIC and African Union on the issues related to Clinical Research and Research Ethics;
- Contribute to the accelerated achievement of the objectives of the African Union as stated in the Constitutive Act of the African Union.
